SXSW Interactive Attendees Can Take Two Minute Mobile App Brain Health Test

AnthroTronix to showcase brain health assessment tool DANATM at SX Health and MedTech Expo booth #505; electronic leaderboard to display scores

Silver Spring, MD - SXSW Interactive participants will have the opportunity to test their brain health using the FDA-cleared app DANATM, which was developed by AnthroTronix (<u>www.atinc.com</u> and <u>@AnthroTronix</u>). As visitors take DANATM, an electronic 'brain vital' leaderboard will display test scores. A Silver Spring, Md.-based engineering research and development firm committed to optimizing the interaction between people and technology, AnthroTronix will be exhibiting March 16-17 at booth #505 at the conference's new <u>SX Health and MedTech Expo</u>.
